Thank you for registering your child for the PACT Summer Day Camp! We are looking forward to having your child as a part of our group. Here is some information for you and your child to go over regarding their upcoming camp experience!

- Every morning your child will check in upon arrival. (Parents are welcome to come in and meet the counselors on the first day!) Campers must be checked out before leaving for the day. We ask that they check in and out so we are aware who is present and who is not
- Our goal is to keep camp fun for everyone and for the campers to gain as much experience as possible! We do ask that campers show respect to their directors, counselors, and other campers. If an issue arises, it will be handled appropriately. If the issue becomes a problem, we will notify you to work with you to handle it!
- We ask that campers not have cell phones at camp, as they can be a distraction to them and others. If you need to contact your child for an emergency, you may call

- Camp begins at 8:00. *You may drop your child off between 7:40 and 8:00.* We ask that you do not arrive any earlier as the counselors have preparations to attend to prior to handling campers!
- Camp ends just before noon – we ask that you pick your child up on time. If you will be late picking up your child, please call the camp director.
- A snack will be provided for your child midway through camp each day. Please do not send any food with your child (unless medically necessary), but a water bottle (labeled with the camper's name) is appropriate and welcome!
- Your camper(s) will be participating in activities that give them experiences in various aspects of the performing arts.
- The campers will be putting on a showcase for their family and friends the evening of the last day of camp. Please plan for your child to be there! They will have worked hard over the duration of the camp and deserve the chance to show off their new skills & talents ☺
